1. Introduction

Peace and Development Action (PDA) is a registered Non-Governmental and Not-for-Profit Organization in the Federal Government of Somalia that is been established in 2008. PDA works for civilians by prioritizing neglected and hard-to-reach areas where access to assistance is limited, and increasingly supports people displaced by natural disasters, the adverse effects of climate change and generalized violence. PDA's core focus areas are the promotion of Human Rights and Democratic Governance and intervention of Emergency Responses like food security and Livelihoods, Water and Sanitation (WASH), Nutrition, Protection, Education, Conflict Resolution and Strengthening of Peace and Stability through Research and Community Dialogue, Youth Empowerment, Civic Education and Community Awareness Raising towards Gender Equity and applying non-violent mechanisms of Conflict Management. PDA's main office is at KM5 (Zobe Area), Hodan District, Banadir, Somalia, with operational presence in Jowhar, Afgooye, Baidao, Beledweyne, Wanlaweyn, Cadaado, Hobyo and South Galkayo.

2. Description of the Tender

In partnership with Somalia Humanitarian Fund (SHF), PDA has received funding from SHF for implementation of project titled "Provision of lifesaving emergency preventive and curative services in Wanlaweyn District Lower Shabelle region" and intends to apply portion of that fund to the payment of supplier for awarding a contract for distribution of Poultry farm to 803 households across the 7 villages (Da'ud Bulle, Tabelaha, Hero, Hakow, Doonka, Maynuun and Waberi) in Wanlaweyn District to support One Egg campaign Per Day, which aims to promote daily consumption of eggs as an affordable nutritious food source for young children, pregnant women, and breastfeeding mothers in Wanlaweyn District.

The 803 households will receive from the supplier vouchers to purchase chickens, thereby enabling households to start small-scale poultry farming, which in turn will support daily egg consumption for young children, pregnant, and breastfeeding women.

The vouchers will cover the basic costs of starting a small poultry farm, such as buying chickens, feed, and other necessary supplies. By investing in these households, the project seeks to improve

household food security, dietary diversity, and the overall nutritional status of vulnerable populations, specifically focusing on young children under 2 years of age.

3. Tender Information

Interested bidders must be registered, and holders of a valid certificate that permits to supply the stated products and service in this tender which issued by the Federal Government of Somalia. In addition to that, bidders are required to possess the provision of similar past experience of relevant activity as measurement of supplier capacity in this tender.

Language, System of Units and Currency of the Bids:

The bid prepared by the bidder and all documents related to the bid must be written in English only. The measurement units used in these bid documents are as in Annex I (Bill of Quantities). The bidders are required to use the same. The currency of this bid shall be in USD (\$).

Duration of Contract:

The estimated duration of the contract proposed by PDA shall be a maximum of one (3) month from the time of signing the contract. If the contractor has a difference in duration, this should be indicated in the offer.

Selection Criteria:

Tenderers not providing all the requested documents and information necessary for evaluation as outlined in this tender document will automatically be disqualified from competing in this process. Additionally, the following will be used as an elimination criterion for participation in this process:

- Non-submission of price of all items in the BOQ
- Incomplete Bid Submission
- Late Bid Submission

Submission of the Bids:

The bid indicating the full name and contact details of the bidder and containing all requested information, must be presented to PDA Office in Mogadishu or Wanlaweyn in a sealed envelope or can be sent by email to **procurement@pda.org.so** with complete tender reference number at the email subject.

Original copy of the bid documents with signature, date and stamp of the bidder must be put in a sealed envelope clearly marked "Distribution of Poultry farm in Wanlaweyn" With Ref No: T/PDA/SHF/NUT/2025/005.

The sealed envelope containing Documents must be deposited at the PDA office in Mogadishu or Wanlaweyn on or before 4.00 PM on **15**th **February 2025**. Please make sure to sign at the logistics office when submitting the bid document. Late submission of offers will not be allowed.
