1. Introduction

Peace and Development Action (PDA) is a registered Non-Governmental and Not-for-Profit Organization in the Federal Government of Somalia that is been established in 2008. PDA works for civilians in armed conflict, prioritizing neglected and hard-to-reach areas where access to assistance is limited, and increasingly supports people displaced by natural disasters, the adverse effects of climate change and generalized violence. PDA's core focus areas are the promotion of Human Rights and Democratic Governance and intervention of Emergency Responses like food security and Livelihoods, Water and Sanitation (WASH), Nutrition, Protection, Education, Conflict Resolution and Strengthening of Peace and Stability through Research and Community Dialogue, Youth Empowerment, Civic Education and Community Awareness Raising towards Gender Equity and applying non-violent mechanisms of Conflict Management. PDA's main office is at KM5 (Zobe Area), Hodan District, Banadir, Somalia, with operational presence in Jowhar, Afgooye, Baidoa, Beledweyne, Wanlaweyn, Cadaado, Hobyo and South Galkayo.

2. Description of the project

In partnership with Somalia Humanitarian Fund (SHF), PDA has received funding from SHF for implementation of project titled "Provision of lifesaving emergency preventive and curative services in Wanlaweyn District Lower Shabelle region" and intends to apply portion of that fund to the payment of a supplier for providing four (4) trainings venue rent, refreshments, lunch and training materials on different topics in each of the four trainings including, integrated management of acute malnutrition (IMAM), Infant and young child feeding/Maternal Infant and young child nutrition (MIYCN), Sexual and Gender-Based Violence (SGBV) / Accountability to Affected Populations (AAP), training and Family MUAC training in Wanlaweyn District.

These trainings are for nutrition staff health members, including Nutrition Officer, Nutrition Nurses, Nutrition Assistants, Nutrition Registrars, screeners and volunteers of Infant and Young Child Feeding Counsellors and Community Health Workers. Additionally, it is for caregivers on family mid upper arm circumference (MUAC) to be trained for measurements and referrals.

These comprehensive trainings aims to equip participants with the essential skills and knowledge needed to effectively promote Infant and Young Child Feeding practices and effectively identify, manage and treat cases of Severe Acute Malnutrition (SAM) without medical complications.

Additionally, they will be trained to refer individuals to stabilization centers for severe cases and facilitate access to Targeted Supplementary Feeding Programs to improve community health outcomes and ensure that malnourished children receive the timely care they need.

3. Tender Information

Interested bidders that holds valid registration from the Government of Somalia with capacity to provide the refreshment and lunch with high quality standard for the training participants and have a training hall with AC that have enough seats to accommodate MIN training participants plus 1 training facilitator (per session) as measurement the technical evaluation for the capacity of supplier to perform in this tender for the six training sessions in Wanlaweyn, should submit their price offer in the tender period.

Language, System of Units and Currency of the Bids:

The bid prepared by the bidder and all documents related to the bid must be written in English only. The measurement units used in these bid documents are as in Annex V (Bill of Quantities). The bidders are required to use the same. The currency of this bid shall be in USD (\$). Quotations stated in other currencies will not be considered during the awarding process.

Duration of Contract:

The estimated duration of the contract proposed by PDA shall be a maximum of (90) days from the time of signing the contract.

Selection Criteria:

Tenderers not providing all the requested documents and information necessary for evaluation as outlined in this tender document will automatically be disqualified from competing in this process. Additionally, the following will be used as an elimination criterion for participation in this process:

- Non-submission of price of all items in the BOQ
- Incomplete Bid Submission
- Late Bid Submission

Submission of the Bids:

The bid indicating the full name and contact details of the bidder and containing all requested information, must be presented to PDA Office in Mogadishu or Wanlaweyn in a sealed envelope or can be sent by email to procurement@pda.org.so with complete tender reference number at the email subject.
